Here are some enemies our children are facing:

THE LION - DECEPTION

"Be sober, be vigilant, because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour." 1 Peter 5:8

The Lion represents deception. The devil tries his best to deceive us. He makes his evil plan look appealing. But his plan is to kill, steal and destroy (our children) (John 10:10). Jesus is called the Lion of Judah (Rev. 5:5). The devil tries to imitate Jesus - DECEPTION. Let's teach our children to know the Real Jesus and His ways.

THE SNAKE - DISOBEDIENCE

When the children of Israel were wandering through the wilderness after they left their bondage in Egypt, they complained and disobeyed God. They murmured against God so much that He sent snakes to bite them. The only way to live from the snake bites, was to look to the brazen serpent that God had Moses to prepare. The brazen serpent was to be placed on a pole and placed where people could see it (Num. 21:4-9). This represented looking to Jesus for salvation because of sin. The snake also represents the devil in the Garden of Eden. Eve chose to disobey God and chose to listen to and believe Satan and his lies. Disobedience brought death. Let's teach our children to be content with what they have - to not listen to Satan and his lies - and look to Jesus for salvation.

THE BEAR - DISRESPECT

We read in 2 Kings 2:23-24 about the 42 children who mocked the prophet, Elisha, and his bald head. Two she bears came out of the woods and mauled those children. Let's teach our children to respect others - not to be bullies - love one another - and to love God.
