General Instructions

Have your Bible visible at all lessons.

You will need a flannelgraph board for most lessons. Place felt on back of pictures so they will stick to the flannelgraph board.

Put all materials in a tote bag so that the children will not see them until lesson time.

Instructions for a sand pan. Fill a plastic tray with sand. Shape the sand in mounds for hills. Break twigs and small limbs from trees for scenery. Insert them in the sand. Place craft sticks on the back of figures to use in the sand pan.

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Star Awards Activities

Use a cupcake pan. Place a question in each cup. Let the child bounce a ping-pong ball into a cup. The child will then answer the question.

Use a tic-tac-toe board. Place a question on each space. Divide into teams. Let each child pick the square they would like to put their X/O. If they answer the question correctly they can mark that square.

Fishing pond - Make fish out of fabric scraps. Place a magnet inside. Pen a question to the fish. Use a pole from a dollar store or make one out of stick/string and a paperclip.

Hot Potato – Pass a ball or bean bag around the circle of children as long as music is playing. When the music stops the child with the ball gets to answer the question.
