Flicker Star Awards activity - Number 1

Flicker Star Awards - The children will review the main ideas and Star Awards requirements taught in Lessons 1 - 4.

Know Memory verses "The Lord gave the Word" Psalm 68:11, "God is Love" I John 4:8

Materials needed: Flicker Visuals 29-37. Copy the questions given below on the backs of the visuals. You may write your own questions. Place each visual in an envelope. Place a simple gift bow on each envelope. Place in a bag used in previous lessons.

You may wish to give small tokens as rewards after questions are answered. Tokens may include crayons, candy, small toys, or bookmarks.

Lesson Approach: Tonight I have something for each of you in my bag. (Let each child, one at a time, reach in and draw out an envelope.) Let's find out what's inside. Can you open the envelope? (Ask each child to tell what is seen in the picture. Ask the appropriate review question. Be sure to have enough envelopes so each child has an opportunity to draw one out.) You may wish to reward correct answers with a small prize.

# Flicker - God's Word - Star Awards Activity 2

Star Awards - review the main ideas and star awards requirements taught in lessons 5 - 7.

Know memory verse: "Honour thy father and thy mother" Exodus 20:12

Materials needed: From the packet, take the large background (Flicker - 56)

Mount the scene on a bulletin board or poster board. You will also need visuals 57 - 65. These figures will be attached to the background scene as the questions are answered. To illustrate the questions, visuals 38 - 40, 43 - 48, 52 and 54 are needed.

Lesson Approach: Attach the house (57) on the background. We have been learning about families. Today, we are going to make a picture of a family and a house. Oh dear, something is very wrong with this house!! Who can tell me what this house needs? (Allow the children time to respond.)

We are going to complete this picture. Everyone will have a turn to add something to the house or the picture, but you will have to answer a question before you may put something on. Let's start with the roof. The one who can answer my first question will get to put the roof on this house.

(Use the questions included in this lesson or make up your own questions. Be sure to let each child have a turn to answer and add something to the picture. Use the listing below to complete the scene.

- 1. roof (flicker 58)
- 2. door (flicker 59)
- 3. windows (flicker 60)
- 4. tree (flicker 61)
- 5. flowers (flicker 62)
- 6. Father (flicker 63)

- 7. Mother (flicker 64)
- 8. Child (flicker 65)

Leave the finished scene in the classroom for the remainder of the Bible Study.)

Star Awards Review Questions for Lessons 5 through 7

- 1. (Hold up the Ten Commandments shape (43). What is this memory verse? Honour thy father and thy mother" Exodus 20:12
- 2. (Show the figures of a family 44-46.) Who gives us our families? God
- 3. (Show the figures 38-40) Name this family that loved God. Mary, Joseph, Jesus.
- 4. (Show figures of the father talking to Jesus 47-48) Whom did the little boy's father ask to make his son well? Jesus
- 5. (Show Parent figures 44 45) Whom should we thank God for each day? Mother and Father
- 6. (Show figure of Hannah 52). Who was this lady? Hannah
- 7. (Show Hannah again.) Whom did she pray to every day? God
- 8. (Show the figure of baby 54) What did she ask God for? a baby

Activity: Give each child a copy of the following art page. Allow the children to color the picture. Emphasize that families are a gift from God.

Extra activity: Give each child an envelope and some craft sticks. Give them enough sticks to represent each member of their immediate family. Let them draw faces on the sticks for each member of their family. Decorate the envelope and let them decorate like their house.

# God Wants Children to Obey

Flicker - Star Awards Activity Number 3

Star Awards - The children will review the main ideas and Star Awards requirements taught in Lessons 8 - 10.

Know the memory verse - Ephesians 6:1 "Children, obey your parents"

Materials needed: Flicker 86 - a bear poster or you may substitute a large stuffed animal .

Also needed for this lesson are a cereal bowl and fruit-flavored dry cereal, nuts or animal crackers. For each child a napkin or paper cup is needed.

To illustrate questions use visuals - Flicker 69, 71,74,80,82,83,84

Lesson Approach: Place the bear poster or stuffed animal on a chair. Place a cereal bowl with your choice of snack in it.

Give each child an opportunity to answer a review question. Use the questions included in this lesson. You may also make up your own questions.

As a child answers a question, he may pick up a piece of food from the bear's bowl and pretend to feed it to the bear. The child may then bring the food back to his seat.

Provide a napkin or paper cup for each child to put his food on. When all the questions have been answered, the children may enjoy their snacks. You will want to have extra so that everyone gets a fair share.
