Concentration

Read a Bible verse aloud together several times and then play Concentration. Print each word of the Bible verse on a separate piece of same-sized paper (i.e., all 3x5 cards or 8-1/2 x 11 sheets of cardstock). Make sure the kids can't see through the back of the paper to read the word on the other side. Make two sets. Mix the two sets of words together and then lay them out in rows to create a grid on the floor. Have students take turns flipping over two words at a time, attempting to find a match. If the two words don't match, have the student turn them back over in their original spots on the grid. If they do match, have the student remove the words from the grid and place them one on top of the other off to the side, where the verse can be constructed as the word pairs are found. After a student finds a match, you can either let him/her have another turn (as in traditional Concentration) or have the turn pass to another student. Continue until all matches have been found and the verse is complete.
