

FEED MY LAMBS – National Sunbeam Craft Idea

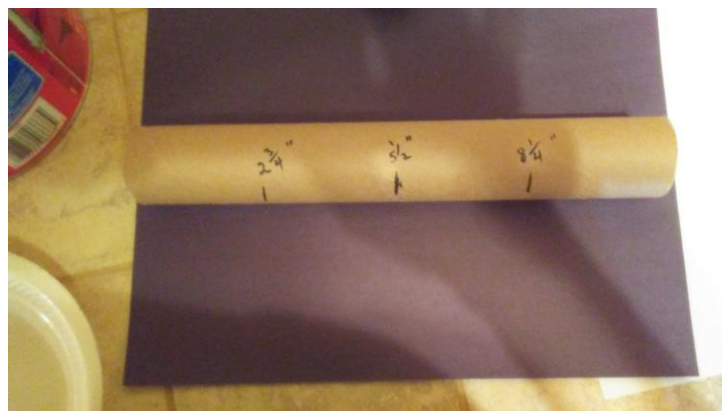
HOW TO MAKE A “FEED MY LAMBS” BANK



Supplies: Container (coffee can, oatmeal box, etc.); two sheets white construction paper; one sheet black construction paper; paper towel roll; a good permanent bond glue (Elmers Extreme); 2 bowls (foam or paper); cotton balls; Lamb face; two wiggly eyes; scissors and transparent tape



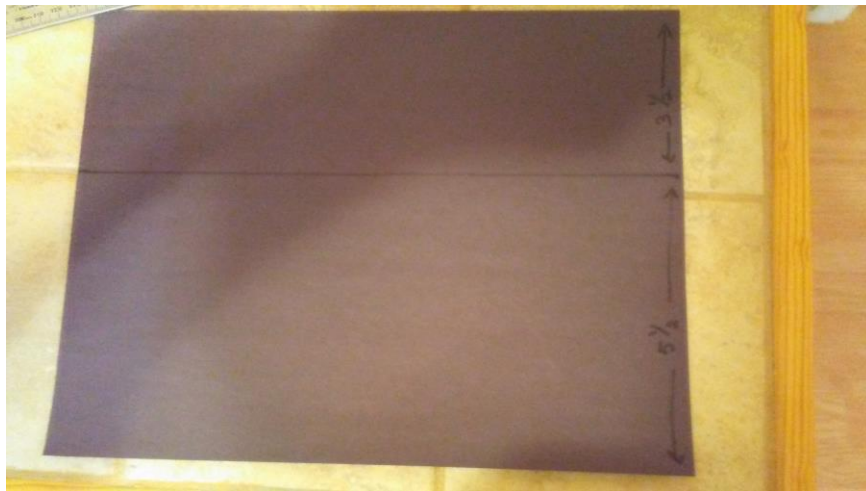
Cut hole for the bank big enough to slide coins, folded bills, checks into.



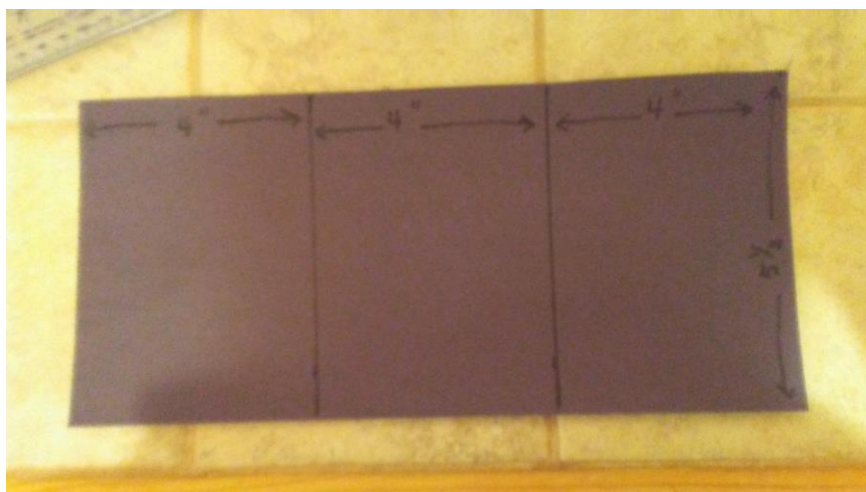
Measure out four equal sections on your paper towel roll



Cut the sections out. I used a sharp knife.



Mark your black paper for the legs. (Bottom section is 5 ½ inches x length of paper. Top section is 3 ½ inches x length of paper.) Then cut on the line.



Mark the bottom section in to 4-inch sections and cut apart.



Mark the top section 5 ½ inches x the 3 ½ inches. Discard the other section. This will now give you a total of four sections for the legs.



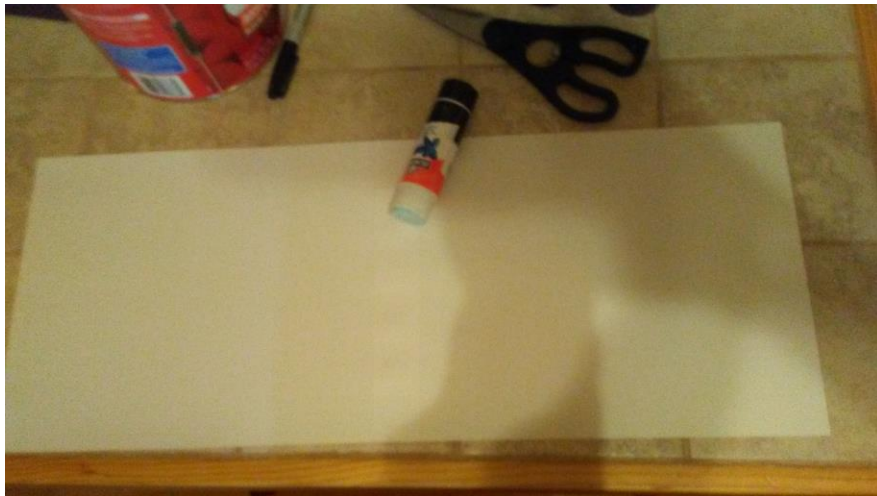
Glue each section to the four paper towel sections making sure one end of the paper is even with the black paper section. It will extend about one inch on the other end. You'll need that extension later.



After all four legs are made, cut the extensions to flare out as shown in picture. This gives you something to glue to the body.



These extensions are too long right now. We'll cut them off some later.



Glue the two pieces of white paper together making one long strip.



Measure the height of your container.



Measure your paper the same as the height of your container. Cut and discard the other piece.



Glue the paper around the container making sure the seams are not in the way of the slit you made for the bank. Glue the side seam down securely.



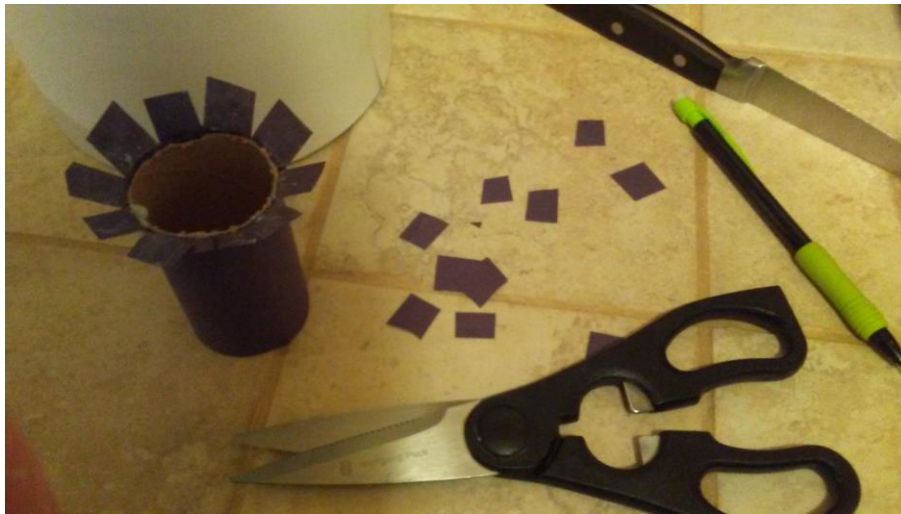
With a knife or scissors cut the opening in the paper where the slit is. You may want to use tape to place around the slit and down into the slit to keep the paper from tearing when inserting the money donations.



The bowl should be as close to the same size of your container lid.



Glue the bowl to the top of the lid.



Trim the extensions of the leg sections to about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch all around.



Glue each leg to the bottom of the container making sure that the bank slit is at the top and legs are on the bottom.



You may have to adjust the positioning of the legs to make sure it will stand up properly.



Glue the other bowl to the bottom of the container.



Glue the Lamb face to the bowl that is attached to the lid.



Glue the wiggly eyes to the Lamb face.



Put the lid on the container. The Lamb's face should be facing forward not upside down.



Glue the cotton balls on the body. Put the glue on the container not the cotton balls. (The cotton will stick to the blue stick...NOT GOOD!)



Make sure you leave the slit open and clear.



Make sure you can take the head (lid) off and remove the money easily.
